I would like to wish everyone a healthy and prosperous Holiday Season!

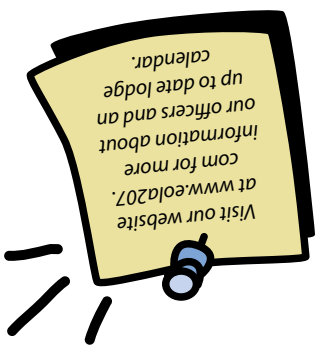
