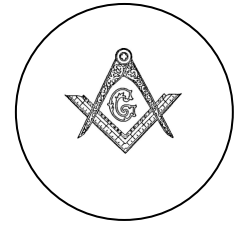

### Masonic Education – Florida Masonic Monitor

#### Three Types of Lodges

There are three different types of Lodges of Free and Accepted Masons authorized by the Charter of the Grand Lodge; they are Subordinate, Individual and Particular. The Subordinate is a Lodge in a lower class to Particular, such as a Memorial Lodge. The Individual Lodge is a Lodge with jurisdiction over certain individuals, such as a Military Lodge. The Particular Lodge is a regular Lodge with territorial and personal jurisdiction, with authority to confer the degrees of Entered Apprentice, Fellow Craft and Master Mason, and to elect and install its Officers.
